Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 17:59 by Eric Davidson.

Approval of previous minutes

- November's minutes were approved.

Public Works

- **Ryan:** (Referring to the salt/sand dispersing unit) We would be able to put it on the F250 if we install a flatbed. It would be used for steep grades and bad intersections.
 - Put the plows on trucks and plowed the last storm
- **Eric D:** Oak Hills – berm left in front of road and many people called about it
 - **Pam:** Talked to County Sheriff's office & Road department and all agree this is a "civil matter".
 - **Eric D:** Talked to lawyers and we have legal right to not plow said road until defaults are cured or a new agreement is met.
 - **Carey:** Played voicemail from sheriffs office concerning resident complaints
 - **Eric D:** Continue with the current plan for road
- **Ryan:** Homeowner asked if there is anything they can do with their trash since Elite won't pick up in winter.
 - **Carey:** One can left at bottom of hill where it has been posted its not allowed
